EXIT STRATEGY

PLAYER TO BE INFORMED OF CLUB DECISION NOT TO OFFER THEM A PLACE ON THE TEAM ONLY WHEN PARENT OR GUARDIAN PRESENT. IDEALLY THIS WILL TAKE PLACE AT MEETING WITH HEAD OF YOUTH. HEAD OF YOUTH WILL CONTACT PARENT IN FIRST INSTANCE TO DISCUSS BEST PROCESS TO FACILITATE.

HEAD OF YOUTH TO PROVIDE PLAYER EVALUATION REPORTS FOR CONSIDERATION. THESE WILL PROVIDE THE BASIS FOR DECISION BEING TAKEN.

ACADEMY DIRECTOR WILL PROVIDE ANY FURTHER INFORMATION REQUIRED AND EXPLAIN EXIT STRATEGY.

ACADEMY DIRECTOR WILL INFORM SFA REGISTRATION DEPARTMENT OF CANCELLATION OF PLAYER'S REGISTRATION.

WITH PARENTS CONSENT ACADEMY DIRECTOR WILL INFORM ALL CAS CLUBS, THE SCOTTISH LEAGUE CLUBS AND THE SCOTTISH AMATEUR LEAGUE OF PLAYERS RELEASE. PARTNER BOYS CLUBS ALSO INFORMED OF PLAYERS AVAILABILITY. IF GRASSROOTS TEAM OPERATING AT PLAYERS AGE GROUP, INCLUSION IN THIS PROGRAMME OFFERED TO PLAYER.

PLAYER TO BE INCLUDED IN CAS EXIT TRIALS IF APPLICABLE.

SCOUT RESPONSIBLE FOR BRINGING THE PLAYER TO CLUB INITIALLY TO LIASE WITH PLAYER AND INFORM ACADEMY DIRECTOR OF PLAYING DESTINATION. PLAYERS DESTINATION TO BE UPDATED BY SCOUT ON REGULAR BASIS.
