

## Role Description – Mascot Supervisor

### Purpose

To supervise mascots on match days.

### Responsibilities

- Greet mascots and family members on entry to the stadium
- Explain the procedures for the day
- Escort family members to pre-match waiting area
- Organise signing of programmes and photographs as players enter the pitch for the warm-up
- Arrange area of pitch for mascots to have a kickabout that does not interfere with the teams
- Introduce mascots to the team captain
- Organise mascots into line for team procession on to the pitch
- Collects mascots at pitchside prior to kick off
- Ensure match day souvenirs are provided
- Escorts mascots and family members to seats in the stand

### Skills and Competencies

- Good organisation and communication skills
- Reliable and trustworthy
- Approachable and friendly
- Have a good manner with young people
- Be proactive in response to crowd issues/problems when they arise

- Flexibility is required regarding attendance on match days
